OVERVIEW

The ABFE Connecting Leaders Fellowship is a year-long experience designed to sharpen the skills and strengthen the leadership capacity of foundation staff, donors, and trustees who are committed to assisting Black communities through philanthropy. Fellows have the opportunity to learn from seasoned grantmakers and peers on a regular basis, understand how to be more effective agents for change within their institutions, and participate in a network that focuses on innovative solutions to community challenges. Fellows attend a week-long Leadership Summit and are assigned an executive coach. In addition, each fellow is required to complete a community-based learning project during the fellowship year. This can be volunteer work or a research project on a topic of interest. Please note that fellows will be based at their home institutions and in their communities during the fellowship year. Who is Eligible to Apply?

The Fellowship is open to anyone that fits the following profile:

- 2+ years of demonstrated experience as a grantmaker, trustee, or donor in organized philanthropy.
- A deep-rooted commitment to assisting Black communities through philanthropy.
- Ability to attend the ABFE Leadership Summit that will be held November 6-10, 2017 in Kansas City, KS. Participation in the Summit is MANDATORY. ABFE covers the costs associated with travel, lodging at the designated host hotel, and group meals.
- An active ABFE Membership is not a prerequisite to apply to the Fellowship, however, all Connecting Leaders Fellows must be current members of ABFE at the time the Fellowship starts. For information about membership, visit us online at ABFE.org.

THE EXPERIENCE

Time Commitment

Participants in the Connecting Leaders Fellowship Program can expect the following time commitment:

- The Leadership Summit is a week-long commitment with full days lasting through dinner. Breaks are scheduled to allow for email check-ins, however, participants should anticipate being busy for the entire week.
- There will be a 90-minute, monthly conference call/webinar for the cohort (see anticipated dates below).
- All calls/webinars will be held at 3:30 PM ET (approximately a 90-minute duration).
- Participants in the Fellowship receive 10 hours of Executive Coaching, usually by phone/skype. These appointments are made directly between the Fellow and the Coach at their convenience.
- Participants in the Fellowship should expect to spend an additional 3 or 4 hours a month preparing for coaching sessions or working on their Community Based Learning Project.
- Fellows are encouraged to attend the ABFE Annual Conference. Please note, the Connecting Leaders Fellowship Program does not provide for Annual Conference expenses, hotel or airfare.

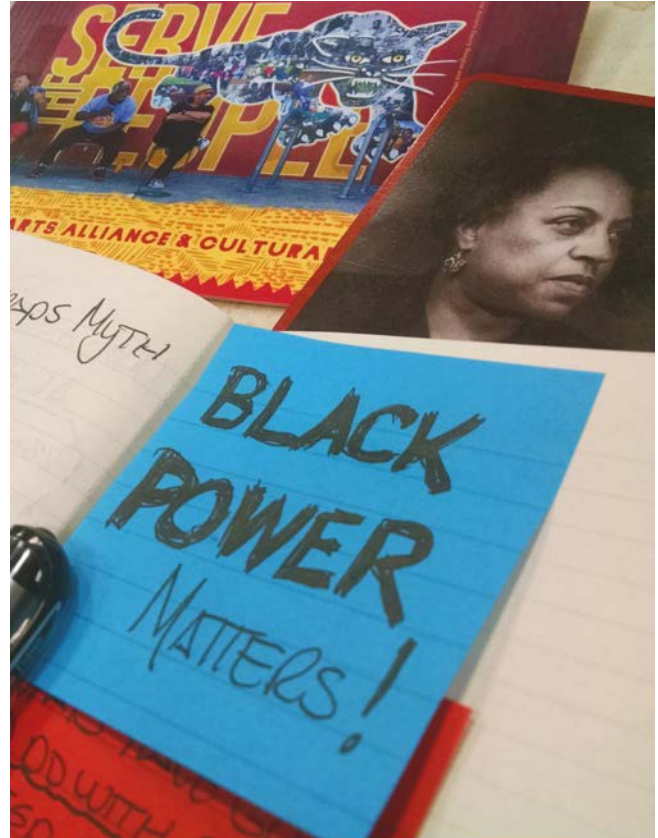

PROGRAM DETAILS



The Connecting Leaders Fellowship is an outstanding professional development opportunity, which includes access to invaluable resources and supports. CLFP offers fellows: one-on-one Executive Coaching; rigorous scientifically-based assessments 360-degree evaluation; the week-long Leadership Summit (including airfare, hotel, meals, ground transportation, and learning experiences; and monthly facilitated cohort calls.

The cost of the Fellowship to Fellows is \$1,500.00, to be paid upon acceptance to the program. Requests for payment plans and limited financial aid will be considered.

The application consists of six (6) essay questions, one letter of accommodation to be uploaded, and an uploaded copy of your resume. You can download a sample application and find additional information about the letter of recommendation on the ABFE website, ABFE.org.
